PURPOSE

This position serves as part of field crew operations to assure high quality water service, including on-call responsibilities, to customers of the Fox Chapel Authority. It provides maintenance on 113 pipeline miles, three stations, five storage facilities, 650 fire hydrants, 5500 services and meters, 12-vehicle fleet, four excavators and general property areas.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Maintain water pipeline, stations, storage facilities, fire hydrants, residential services/meters, vehicle fleet and Authority physical property.
- 2. Detect and repair leaks.
- 3. Install replacement water lines.
- 4. Install customer taps.
- 5. Provide customer service in the field, including meter reading, related to job responsibilities.*
- 6. Provide on-call coverage as assigned.
- 7. Perform maintenance duties related to the physical assets of the Fox Chapel Authority as required.
